## **Christmas Cards**

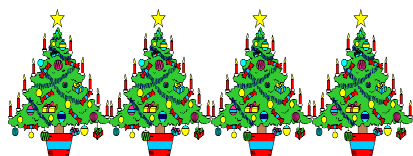
