The shooting down of the Luftschiffe 31 aircraft on 1 October 1916 proved a turning point in World War 1. To mark the 100th anniversary of this evocative event, Hertsmere Borough Council in partnership with Potters Bar Museum and The Battlefields Trust and supported by the Heritage Lottery Fund are providing a series of activities in Oakmere Park, Potters Bar where the great airship plunged to Earth.
