

## Rounding:

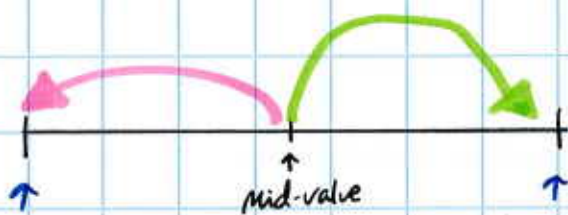
In Year Six, children are expected to round any whole number (referred to as integers) to the required degree of accuracy. We use the same method to round any number that we're working with.

Begin by drawing the following:



Then, insert the values you're using for your question eg

4,368 rounded to the nearest 100



The "hundreds" number before 4,368

The "hundreds" number after 4,368



Insert the value you're rounding (4,368 in this case) accurately on the number line. This ~~total~~ will then tell you whether to "round down" or "round up".

So, 4,368 rounded to the nearest 100 = 4,400
